## **COMMITTEE REPORT**

## **MADAM PRESIDENT:**

The Senate Committee on Public Policy, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 144, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

1	Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
2	paragraph and insert:
3	"SECTION 1. IC 7.1-1-2-1.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
4	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
5	1, 2021]: Sec. 1.5. If any provision, or application of any provision,
6	of this title concerning the manufacture, importation, distribution,
7	or retail sale of alcoholic beverages is deemed to be in conflict with
8	federal law or unconstitutional, the remainder of this title
9	concerning the manufacture, importation, distribution, or retail
10	sale of alcoholic beverages shall be construed to limit rather than
11	expand the manufacture, importation, distribution, and retail sale
12	of alcoholic beverages through a three-tier system.
13	SECTION 2. IC 7.1-1-3-46.8 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
14	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
15	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 46.8. The term "three-tier
16	system" means the legal and regulatory framework for the
17	manufacture, importation, distribution, and retail sale of alcoholic
18	beverages within Indiana. The term includes the real and
19	substantial segregation of the interests, ownership, and operations
20	among the manufacture, importation, distribution, and retail sale

1 of alcoholic beverages within Indiana.".

2 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively. (Reference is to SB 144 as printed February 12, 2021.)

and when so amended that said bill do pass.
