MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Commerce and Technology, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 150, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

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| 2 | A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning |

| 4 | Replace the effective dates in SECTIONS 1 through 3 with |
| 5 | "[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2025]". |

| 16 | serves as an ex officio member of the task force. |
| 17 | (7) The director of the legislative services agency's office of |
| 18 | technology services, who serves as an ex officio member of the |
| 19 | task force.". |

| 11 | (e) An individual appointed to fill a vacancy must meet the |
| 12 | qualifications of the vacancy. |
| 13 | (f) An individual appointed to fill a vacancy serves for the |
| 14 | remainder of the term of the member the individual is appointed |
| 15 | to replace. |
| 16 | (g) The chief information officer serves as a nonvoting member |
| 17 | of the task force.". |
