<u>Summary of Legislation:</u> This bill requires the Indiana Department of Health (IDOH) to conduct an air quality study of every school located in Indiana.

Effective Date: July 1, 2025.

Explanation of State Expenditures: Indiana Department of Health (IDOH): The bill increases costs and workload at the IDOH during FY 2026 to conduct a study of every school's air quality control measures, and to report the findings to the General Assembly no later than July 1, 2026. Current law requires the IDOH to inspect the indoor air quality for schools based on a complaint or concern. IDOH has three Industrial Hygienists personnel within the Environmental Public Health Division. Existing staffing and resource levels, if currently being used to capacity, may be insufficient for full implementation. Ultimately, the source of funds and resources required to satisfy the requirements of this bill will depend on legislative and administrative actions. [IDOH's administrative expenditures are paid from the Tobacco Master Settlement Fund, a dedicated fund.]
