<u>Summary of Legislation:</u> (Amended) The bill provides that in a county having a population within certain parameters, a local flood plain administrator may issue a variance allowing a structure located in a floodway to remain in its location without a permit issued by the director of the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) if the structure is an abode or residence, a permit for the construction of the abode or residence was issued by the appropriate official of the county before December 19, 2018, and other conditions are met.

Effective Date: Upon passage.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** (Revised) The bill could decrease the immediate workload of the DNR (for removal of an abode or residence in a floodway) by allowing the Wayne County flood plain administrators to issue a variance to allow a structure located in a floodway to remain in its location without a DNR permit if certain conditions are met.
