MR. SPEAKER:

Your Committee on <u>Natural Resources</u>, to which was referred <u>Senate Bill 373</u>, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:

1	Page 1, delete lines 1 through 15.
2	Delete pages 2 through 14.
3	Page 15, delete lines 1 through 9, begin a new paragraph and insert:
4	"SECTION 1. IC 14-39-1-3.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.291-2019,
5	SECTION 5, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
6	JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 3.5. (a) This chapter authorizes the establishment
7	of a carbon sequestration pilot project:
8	(1) that will:
9	(A) capture carbon dioxide at the proposed ammonia
10	hydrogen plant to be located at 444 West Sanford Avenue,
11	West Terre Haute, Indiana; and
12	(B) inject the carbon dioxide underground through one (1) or
13	more injection wells pursuant to a Class VI well permit issued

1	by the United States Environmental Protection Agency; and
2	(2) that will employ the underground storage injection of carbon
3	dioxide as an alternative to releasing the carbon dioxide into the
4	air.
5	(b) The director shall designate the operator of the carbon
6	sequestration pilot project according to the characteristics of the pilot
7	project set forth in subsection (a) before July 31, 2021.
8	SECTION 2. IC 14-39-1-14.1 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
9	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
10	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 14.1. (a) This section applies to a
11	civil action filed after June 30, 2021.
12	(b) Except as provided in subsection (e), material compliance by
13	the carbon sequestration pilot project with a Class VI injection
14	well permit issued by the United States Environmental Protection
15	Agency is an affirmative defense against any civil action or claim
16	for damages or equitable relief alleging infringement of or
17	interference with real or personal property rights or interests that
18	relates to:
19	(1) an injection through; or
20	(2) the migration of injectate from;
21	an injection well subject to the permit.
22	(c) A claimant may overcome the defense provided by
23	subsection (b) by proving:
24	(1) actual interference with the reasonable and foreseeable use
25	of the property; or
26	(2) direct physical injury to tangible property.
27	(d) For the purposes of subsection (c), a diminution in property
28	value due to a perceived risk that operation of the pilot project
29	may cause damage or injury does not constitute direct physical
30	injury to tangible property.
31	(e) This section does not prohibit or limit recovery by a public
32	utility for any effect of the carbon dioxide pilot project on the
33	sources of the public water supply used by the public utility.".
34	Page 15, delete lines 13 through 42, begin a new paragraph and
35	insert:
36	"Chapter 16. Voluntary Carbon Credit Program Report
37	Sec. 1. The department and the department of natural resources
38	shall, in consultation with:

1	(1) Purdue University;
2	(2) agricultural producers;
3	(3) woodland owners;
4	(4) foresters;
5	(5) technical experts in the area of carbon verification and
6	voluntary carbon credit markets;
7	(6) representatives of:
8	(A) the agricultural industry; and
9	(B) the forest industry; and
10	(7) environmental and conservation groups;
11	study and make findings and recommendations concerning the
12	potential role of the state in a voluntary carbon credit market.
13	Sec. 2. Before July 1, 2022, the department and the department
14	of natural resources shall:
15	(1) issue a written report of the findings and
16	recommendations made under section 1 of this chapter; and
17	(2) submit the report in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6
18	to the executive director of the legislative services agency for
19	distribution to the members of the general assembly.
20	Sec. 3. This chapter expires July 1, 2022.".
21	Delete pages 16 through 22.
22	Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
