DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 21-14-2-13.

Synopsis: Higher education expenses. Requires a state educational institution, each semester (or its equivalent), to provide to each student enrolled in the state educational institution: (1) a statement of the total amount of money the student is paying to the state educational institution to attend the state educational institution for that semester (or its equivalent); and (2) an itemized invoice of the expenses for which the student's payment is being used.

Effective: July 1, 2017.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning higher education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

(C) administrator salaries;
(D) any other administrative costs;
(E) maintaining the campus of the state educational
institution, including buildings and landscaping;
(F) food and meals;
(G) sports;
(H) investment in future projects, including buildings;
(I) marketing; and
(J) any other expenses for which the money paid by the
student is being used.
