DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 21-27.

Synopsis: Tuition caps. Requires that the tuition rate and mandatory fees at specified postsecondary educational institutions may not increase from the time the student initially enrolls until the student graduates for an undergraduate student who is an Indiana resident.

Effective: July 1, 2020.
