DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 10-21-1-14; IC 20-19-3; IC 20-25; IC 20-28-3-3; IC 20-31; IC 20-36-2-1.

Synopsis: Elimination of school improvement plans. Repeals the requirement that a public school or a state accredited nonpublic school develop an initial three year strategic and continuous school improvement and achievement plan. Removes language referencing school improvement and achievement plans.

Effective: July 1, 2024.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
