DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-28-9-26.

Synopsis: Minimum teacher salaries. Provides that, for each school year beginning after June 30, 2025, a school corporation shall, if the school corporation determines that the school corporation cannot establish a minimum salary of \$60,000 for each full-time teacher, submit a report to the department of education explaining the school corporation's inability to meet the minimum threshold requirement. (Current law establishes this requirement if a school corporation determines that the school corporation cannot establish a minimum salary of \$40,000 for each full-time teacher.)

Effective: July 1, 2024.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 20-28-9-26, AS ADDED BY P.L.165-2021.		
SECTION 154, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS		
[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2024]: Sec. 26. (a) For each school year		
beginning after June 30, 2022, if a school corporation determines that		
the school corporation cannot establish a minimum salary of forty		
thousand dollars (\$40,000) for each full-time teacher, the school		
corporation shall submit a report to the department explaining the		
school corporation's inability to meet the minimum threshold		
requirement. This subsection expires July 1, 2025.		

- (b) For each school year beginning after June 30, 2025, if a school corporation determines that the school corporation cannot establish a minimum salary of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) for each full-time teacher, the school corporation shall submit a report to the department explaining the school corporation's inability to meet the minimum threshold requirement.
- (b) (c) A report submitted under this section must include an explanation of the financial challenges, with detailed data, that



1	preclude the school corporation from meeting the minimum salary
2	threshold required under subsection (a) (before its expiration) or
3	subsection (b). The report must also describe the cost saving measures
4	taken by the school corporation in attempting to meet the minimum
5	salary threshold required under subsection (a) (before its expiration)
6	or subsection (h)
