Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) The legislative

4	(1) The prevention, detection, and treatment of mental health
5	problems affecting school children.
6	(2) Substance use disorders.
7	(3) The mental health of the homeless.
8	(4) The impact of individuals with poor mental health on the
9	criminal justice system.
10	(5) Suicide prevention.
11	(b) This SECTION expires January 1, 2020.
12	SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
