# HOUSE BILL No. 1044

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 4-13-16.5-10.

**Synopsis:** Report concerning state expenditures. Requires the department of administration to provide information annually to the governor, the general assembly, and the public concerning the participation of minority and women's business enterprises in contracts and subcontracts of each state agency for the prior state fiscal year.

Effective: July 1, 2014.

### Introduced

### HOUSE BILL No. 1044

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state offices and administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 4-13-16.5-10 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2014]: Sec. 10. (a) Not later than October 1
4	of each year, the department shall provide to the governor and the
5	general assembly and post on the department's Internet web site a
6	report containing the following information concerning
7	participation by certified minority and women's business
8	enterprises in contracts and subcontracts entered into by each state
9	agency and concerning the amount spent by each state agency
10	during the preceding state fiscal year under those contracts and
11	subcontracts. The report must include the following:
12	(1) The total number and dollar value of procurement

(1) The total number and dollar value of procurement contracts between the state agency and certified minority and women's business enterprises, whether the certified minority and women's business enterprise participated as a prime contractor or subcontractor, and the classification of the

2	(2) The percentage that the minority and women's business
3	enterprise procurement contracts represent of the total
4	procurement contracts entered into by the state agency.
5	(3) The total number and names of certified minority and
6	women's business enterprises that participated as prime
7	contractors or subcontractors.
8	(4) A brief description of each contract or subcontract
9	reported under this subsection.
10	(5) A description of the state agency's minority and women's
11	business enterprise program, including a description of the
12	effectiveness of the program.
13	(6) Other information required by the department.
14	(b) The department shall compile data required under
15	subsection (a) for inclusion on the Internet web site maintained by
16	the department.
17	(c) The information provided to the general assembly under this
18	section must be in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6.
