

HOUSE BILL No. 1058

DIGEST OF HB 1058 (Updated January 21, 2015 3:20 pm - DI 69)

Citations Affected: IC 33-33.

Synopsis: Vanderburgh circuit court magistrate. Allows the judge of the Vanderburgh circuit court to appoint a second full-time magistrate. (The introduced version of this bill was prepared by the interim study committee on courts and the judiciary.)

Effective: July 1, 2015.
