

HOUSE BILL No. 1059

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 35-31.5-2-115.5.

Synopsis: Emergency medical services providers. Amends the definition of "emergency medical services provider" for the offense of battery to include a staff member in the emergency department of a hospital.

Effective: July 1, 2023.

HOUSE BILL No. 1059

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 35-31.5-2-115.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.238-2015,
2 SECTION 7, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2023]: Sec. 115.5. **(a)** "Emergency medical services provider",
4 **for purposes of IC 35-42-2-1**, has the meaning set forth in
5 IC 16-41-10-1. **This term includes a staff member in the emergency**
6 **department of a hospital.**

7 **(b)** "Emergency medical services provider", for purposes of
8 IC 35-44.1-3-1 and IC 35-46-1-4, has the meaning set forth in
9 IC 16-41-10-1.
