

HOUSE BILL No. 1068

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-34-9.

Synopsis: Protection of special education students. Requires each school corporation and charter school to maintain video surveillance with a camera containing auditory capability in each classroom used to provide instruction to students with a disability.

Effective: July 1, 2018.

HOUSE BILL No. 1068

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-34-9 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
2 A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2018]:
4 **Chapter 9. Classroom Surveillance**
5 **Sec. 1. (a) Each school corporation and charter school must**
6 **maintain video surveillance with a camera containing auditory**
7 **capability in each classroom used to provide instruction to students**
8 **with a disability (as defined in IC 20-35-1-8).**
9 **(b) This section does not apply to an integrated general**
10 **education classroom unless the classroom is used for any part of**
11 **the school day to provide instruction solely to students with a**
12 **disability.**
