DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 7.1-5-10-24.

Synopsis: Alcohol self-service displays. Prohibits a liquor dealer from selling liquor through a self-service display, except for self-service displays in: (1) a package liquor store; or (2) a partitioned or enclosed area of the premises of a liquor dealer that prohibits the entry of a minor into the area without a parent or guardian who is at least 21 years of age.

Effective: July 1, 2014.

HOUSE BILL No. 1073

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning alcohol and tobacco.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 7.1-5-10-24 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1, 2014]: Sec. 24. (a) As used in this section, "self-service display"
4	means a display that contains liquor in an area where a customer:
5	(1) is permitted; and
6	(2) has access to the liquor without assistance from a
7	salesperson.
8	(b) This section does not apply to a self-service display located:
9	(1) on the premises of a package liquor store; or
10	(2) in the partitioned or enclosed area of the premises of a
11	liquor dealer that prohibits the entry of a minor into the area
12	without a parent or guardian who is at least twenty-one (21)
13	years of age.
14	(c) The holder of a liquor dealer permit may not sell or
15	distribute liquor through a self-service display.
