DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 16-18-2; IC 16-42-5.5; IC 35-52-16-86.5.

Synopsis: Ban on high fructose corn syrup as food ingredient. Prohibits businesses from using high fructose corn syrup in food in Indiana.

Effective: July 1, 2024.
