## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 5-10-10-4.

**Synopsis:** Tactical emergency medicine provider death benefit. Extends the public safety officer special death benefit to a tactical emergency medicine provider who dies in the line of duty after June 30, 2015.

Effective: July 1, 2015.
