A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 16-41-7-4.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1,2016]: Sec. 4.5. (a) A provider who diagnoses a patient with acute
4	or chronic hepatitis C shall report the information required by
5	subsection (b) to either:
6	(1) the local health department in the county in which the
7	patient resides; or
8	(2) the state department.
9	(b) The report under subsection (a) must include the following
10	information concerning the patient who has been diagnosed with
11	hepatitis C:
12	(1) Name.
13	(2) Age and date of birth.
14	(3) Race.
15	(4) Address.
16	(5) Any known risk factors for the transmission from the
17	individual.



1	(c) The information reported under this section shall remain
2	confidential and may be used solely for the purpose of compiling
3	data and statistics.
