DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 35-33-8-0.6.

Synopsis: Ban on public funding of bail paying organization. Prohibits the state and a political subdivision from: (1) posting bail for any person; or (2) providing a grant to any entity that provides funding for any person. Prohibits an entity that has received a grant from the state or a political subdivision from posting bail for any person or providing a grant, directly or indirectly, to an entity that posts bail for any person.

Effective: Upon passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

3	UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 0.6. (a) Neither the state nor a political
4	subdivision (as defined in IC 36-1-2-13) of the state may:
5	(1) post bail for any person; or
6	(2) provide a grant or other funding to an entity that posts
7	bail for any person.
8	(b) No entity that has received a grant or funding from the state
9	or a political subdivision (as defined in IC 36-1-2-13) of the state
10	may use the grant or funding to:
11	(1) post bail for any person; or
12	(2) provide a grant or other funding, directly or through
13	another entity, to an entity that posts bail for any person.
14	SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
