A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

6	(1) installed by the bus's manufacturer in compliance with
7	requirements of a state other than Indiana; and
8	(2) not required under:
9	(A) IC 9-19-13;
10	(B) rules adopted by the committee; or
11	(C) IC 20-27-9.
