**Synopsis:** Marion County fairgrounds noise mitigation. Requires installation of industry standard noise barriers at the Marion County fairgrounds in connection with automotive races or events.

Effective: July 1, 2023.

## **HOUSE BILL No. 1100**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning agriculture and animals.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 36-1-28-3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE

3	1, 2023]: Sec. 3. (a) This section applies to Marion County.
4	(b) As used in this section, "board" refers to the:
5	(1) board of directors of an agricultural fair society,
6	association, or corporation that is organized under

8	(2) county legislative body;
9	that owns a county fairgrounds or, by agreement with the owner,
0	operates the county fairgrounds.
1	(c) "Industry standard noise barrier" means a physical
2	obstruction constructed between a noise source and residences that
3	lowers the noise level, including the following:
4	(1) Stand-alone noise walls.
5	(2) Noise berms constructed from earth or material.
6	(3) Combination berm and wall systems.
7	(d) The board shall erect industry standard noise barriers at the

- 2 hosts or plans to host at least five (5) automotive races or events at
- 3 times other than the time of the regularly scheduled county fair.
- 4 (e) This section expires December 31, 2027.
