DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 36-7-4-311.

Synopsis: Plan commission executive director. Provides that: (1) the county executive may appoint the executive director of an area plan commission; and (2) if the county executive does not appoint the executive director within 45 days of a vacancy in the position, the area plan commission may appoint the executive director. (Under current law, the area plan commission appoints the executive director.)

Effective: July 1, 2019.

HOUSE BILL No. 1103

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 36-7-4-311 IS AMENDED TO READ AS 2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 311. (a) ADVISORY. 3 The advisory plan commission may appoint, prescribe the duties, and 4 fix the compensation of such employees as are necessary for the 5 discharge of the duties of the commission. This compensation must be 6 in conformity with salaries and compensation fixed up to that time by 7 the fiscal body of the municipality or county, as the case may be. The 8 commission may contract for special or temporary services and any 9 professional counsel.

10 (b) AREA. The area plan commission shall county executive may 11 appoint an executive director for the planning department and fix the 12 director's compensation. If the county executive does not appoint an 13 executive director and fix the director's compensation within 14 forty-five (45) days of a vacancy in the position, then the area plan 15 commission may appoint the executive director and fix the 16 director's compensation.

(c) AREA. To be qualified for the position, the executive director



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- 1 must have training and experience in the field of planning and zoning.
- 2 The commission entity that appoints the executive director may not
- 3 give any consideration to political affiliation in the appointment of the
- 4 executive director.
