DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Synopsis: Abstract of township receipts and expenditures. Requires township trustees to publish the annual abstract of receipts and expenditures within four weeks after the third Tuesday following the first Monday in February.

Effective: January 1, 2014 (retroactive).

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

13	(4) showing the sum of money remaining in each fund of the
14	township at the end of the year;
15	(5) containing a statement of receipts, showing their source; and
16	(6) containing a statement of expenditures, showing the combined

1 2	gross payment, according to classification of expense, to each person.
3	(b) Within four (4) weeks after the third Tuesday following the first
4	Monday in January , February , the executive shall publish the abstract
5	prescribed by subsection (a) in accordance with IC 5-3-1. The abstract
6	must state that a complete and detailed annual report and the
7	accompanying vouchers showing the names of persons paid money by
8	the township have been filed with the county auditor, and that the
9	chairman of the township legislative body has a copy of the report that
10	is available for inspection by any taxpayer of the township.
11	(c) An executive who fails to comply with this section commits a
12	Class C infraction.
13	SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
