## **HOUSE BILL No. 1106**

## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 36-8-11-15.5.

**Synopsis:** Fire and emergency medical service levy. Authorizes the board of fire trustees (board) of a fire protection district (district) that consists of territory located in west Porter Township in Porter County to adopt a resolution providing that, in addition to any other powers and duties, the district shall establish, operate, and maintain emergency medical services within the territory of the fire protection district. Provides a procedure for the board to obtain an increase of the district's maximum permissible ad valorem property tax levy for fire and emergency medical services if the board adopts such a resolution.

Effective: July 1, 2021.

## **HOUSE BILL No. 1106**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 36-8-11-15.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 15.5. (a) This section applies only
4	to a district that consists of territory located in west Porte
5	Township in Porter County.
6	(b) The board of a district may, before August 1, 2021, adopt
7	resolution providing that, in addition to any other powers and
8	duties under this chapter, the district shall, effective January 1
9	2022, establish, operate, and maintain emergency medical services
10	within the territory of the district.
11	(c) The board of the district may contract for emergency
12	medical services under this section.
13	(d) The expenses of establishing, operating, and maintaining
14	emergency medical services within the district:
15	(1) shall be included in the district's annual budget adopted
16	under section 18 of this chapter; and
17	(2) shall be paid from the district's tax levy imposed under



1	this chapter and from other revenue of the district.
2	(e) The board may, upon approval by the county fiscal body,
3	submit a petition to the department of local government finance for
4	an increase in the district's maximum permissible ad valorem
5	property tax levy for fire and emergency medical services for
6	property taxes first due and payable in 2022.
7	(f) If the board submits a petition in accordance with subsection
8	(a) before August 1, 2021, the department of local government
9	finance shall increase the district's maximum permissible ad
10	valorem property tax levy for fire and emergency medical services
11	for property taxes first due and payable in 2022 by seventy-five

thousand dollars (\$75,000). (g) The district's maximum permissible ad valorem property tax levy for fire and emergency medical services for property taxes first due and payable in 2022, as adjusted under this section, shall be used in the determination of the district's maximum permissible ad valorem property tax levy for fire and emergency medical services for property taxes first due and payable after 2022.
