DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 16-41-18.7.

Synopsis: Information concerning cytomegalovirus infection. Requires the Indiana department of health to: (1) establish and administer a public education program to provide information on cytomegalovirus to pregnant women; and (2) distribute the information to specified persons. Requires a clinic or medical facility that offers fertility care to make the information concerning cytomegalovirus available to patients of the clinic or facility.
