

HOUSE BILL No. 1112

DIGEST OF HB 1112 (Updated February 7, 2023 11:35 am - DI 147)

Citations Affected: IC 12-15.

Synopsis: Medicaid reimbursement for dental services. Specifies that Medicaid dental service reimbursement rates (reimbursement rates) must at least be in the fiftieth percentile of one of the specified fee schedules. Requires the office of the secretary of family and social services to: (1) annually review reimbursement rates; and (2) adjust the reimbursement rates based on the review. Requires the new reimbursement rates to be provided before December 15 of each year to the house committee on ways and means and the senate committee on appropriations.

Effective: July 1, 2023.

HOUSE BILL No. 1112

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning Medicaid.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 12-15-13-10 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2023]: Sec. 10. (a) The office shall reimburse
4	for dental services at a rate that is at least in the fiftieth percentile
5	of one (1) of the following:
6	(1) The American Dental Association, East North Central
7	division fee schedule.
8	(2) The National Dental Advisory Service fee schedule.
9	(b) Before October 1 of each year, the office of the secretary
0	shall:
1	(1) review the:
2	(A) Medicaid reimbursement rates for dental services in
3	states surrounding Indiana;
4	(B) Medicaid provider trends in Indiana; and
5	(C) health care services producer price index for dental
6	care rates; and
7	(2) adjust the Indiana Medicaid reimbursement rates for



1	dental services for the following calendar year based on the
2	review conducted in subdivision (1).
3	(c) Before December 15 of each year, the office of the secretary
4	shall submit the reimbursement rates determined in subsection (b)
5	in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6 to the following:
6	(1) The house committee on ways and means.
7	(2) The senate committee on appropriations.
