DIGEST OF HB 1117 (Updated January 14, 2014 11:12 am - DI 109)

Citations Affected: IC 10-17.

**Synopsis:** Hoosier women veterans program. Establishes the Hoosier women veterans program to provide information and services to Indiana's women veterans. Establishes the Hoosier women veterans program fund.

Effective: January 1, 2015.

### **HOUSE BILL No. 1117**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning military and veterans and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 10-17-14 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
AS A <b>NEW</b> CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
JANUARY 1, 2015]:
Chapter 14. Hoosier Women Veterans Program
Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "coordinator" refers to the
Hoosier women veterans coordinator designated under section 7 of
this chapter.
Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "department" refers to the
Indiana department of veterans' affairs established by
IC 10-17-1-2.
Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "director" refers to the director
of veterans' affairs.
Sec. 4. As used in this chapter, "program" refers to the Hoosier
women veterans program established by section 6 of this chapter.
Sec. 5. As used in this chapter, "women veterans" means women
who:



1	(1) served in the armed forces of the United States; and
2	(2) were discharged under conditions other than dishonorable.
3	Sec. 6. The Hoosier women veterans program is established
4	within the department.
5	Sec. 7. The director shall designate a coordinator who shall be
6	responsible for the administration of the program under the
7	direction and supervision of the director.
8	Sec. 8. The program shall have the following purposes and
9	duties:
10	(1) Perform outreach to improve women veterans' awareness
l 1	of eligibility for federal and state veterans' services and
12	benefits.
13	(2) Assess the needs of women veterans with respect to
14	benefits and services.
15	(3) Review programs, research projects, and other initiatives
16	designed to address or meet the needs of Indiana's women
17	veterans.
18	(4) Make recommendations to the director to improve benefits
19	and services for women veterans.
20	(5) Incorporate women veterans' issues in strategic planning
21	concerning benefits and services.
22	Sec. 9. The program's principal functions are as follows:
23	(1) To advocate:
24	(A) for women veterans and work to increase public
25	awareness about the gender specific needs of women
26	veterans; and
27	(B) for legislation and policies on the local, state, and
28	national levels to address women veterans issues;
29	(2) To collaborate with federal, state, and private entities that
30	provide services to women veterans.
31	(3) To monitor and research issues relating to women
32	veterans and disseminate information and opportunities
33	throughout its network.
34	(4) To educate, provide guidance, and direction to women
35	veterans who apply for:
36	(A) grants;
37	(B) benefits; or
38	(C) services;
39	through conferences, seminars, and training workshops with
10	federal, state, and private entities.
11	(5) To recognize, promote, and honor women veterans
12	through organized activities and events.



1	(6) To provide resources to support the program through
2	grants and other sources of funding.
3	Sec. 10. (a) The Hoosier women veterans program fund is
4	established to carry out the purposes of this chapter. The
5	department shall administer the fund.
6	(b) The fund consists of appropriations from the general
7	assembly and gifts and grants to the fund.
8	(c) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not
9	currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same
10	manner as other public funds may be invested.
11	(d) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not
12	revert to the state general fund. However, if the fund is abolished,
13	the money in the fund reverts to the state general fund.
14	(e) Money in the fund is continuously appropriated for the
15	purposes of this chapter.
16	Sec. 11. The department may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to
17	implement this chapter.
