## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 16-21-6-3.1.

**Synopsis:** Publication of Medicare information. Requires a hospital to publish Medicare reimbursement amounts for health care services provided by the hospital and Medicare quality rating information concerning the hospital.

First Regular Session of the 120th General Assembly (2017)

## HOUSE BILL No. 1138

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 16-21-6-3.1 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
3 1, 2017]: **Sec. 3.1. A hospital shall make public on the hospital's**  
4 **Internet web site (and in paper form, upon request, at the**  
5 **hospital's actual cost):**  
6 **(1) the amount at which the hospital is reimbursed by**  
7 **Medicare for each type of health care service provided by the**  
8 **hospital; and**  
9 **(2) the hospital's Medicare quality rating information.**
