



## **ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1141**

DIGEST OF HB 1141 (Updated March 26, 2019 11:54 am - DI 125)

Citations Affected: IC 9-25.

Synopsis: Traffic amnesty program. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles to administer an amnesty program to reduce reinstatement fees for suspended driving privileges, and establishes criteria for the program.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

### ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1141

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 9-25-6-15.2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
AS A <b>NEW</b> SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
1, 2019]: Sec. 15.2. (a) The bureau shall administer an amnesty
program to reduce reinstatement fees for the reinstatement of a
driving license that was suspended under this article before
January 1, 2019, under section 15 of this chapter as set forth in this
section.

- (b) An individual who is liable for a reinstatement fee for the reinstatement of a driving license that was suspended under this article before January 1, 2019, may file a petition with the bureau for a reduction of the reinstatement fee in the individual's county of residence. The individual must include with a petition filed under this subsection proof of future financial responsibility in the form and in the manner required by the bureau.
- (c) A petition filed under subsection (b) must be filed after September 30, 2019, and before October 1, 2020.
  - (d) The bureau shall reduce an individual's liability to pay a

3	(1) The reinstatement fee is for the reinstatement of a driving

6	(2) The individual files a petition with the bureau under

13	reinstatement fee that is granted by the bureau under this section

15	(1) the amount of the reinstatement fee imposed under section
16	15 of this chapter; multiplied by
17	(2) fifty percent (50%).
18	(f) This section expires July 1, 2021.

Page 2, line 18, delete "a valid driver's license." and insert "**driving privileges.**".

Page 3, between lines 23 and 24, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"(g) A petition filed under this section is not an admission of guilt or liability.".

Page 4, line 42, after "bureau." insert "The court shall include in its order a statement that the order is not a conviction, finding of guilt, or finding of liability.".
