HOUSE BILL No. 1142

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 15-20-5.

Synopsis: Retail sale of dogs and cats. Prohibits a retail pet store from selling or offering to sell a dog or cat unless the dog or cat is obtained from an animal shelter, a humane society, an animal rescue operation, an animal control agency, or a governmental entity operating an animal shelter or other animal impounding facility. Requires that a retail pet store maintain certain records for not less than one year after the dog or cat is sold, adopted, or given away. Provides that a retail pet store must post the name and business address of the person or organization from which the dog or cat was obtained on the dog or cat's cage. Makes it a Class C infraction if a retail pet store violates these provisions.

Effective: July 1, 2021.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning agriculture and animals.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

5	Sec. 5. (a) An owner or operator of a retail pet store who sells of
6	offers for sale a dog or cat as provided in section 4 of this chapter

10	(2) The sex and color of the dog or cat.
11	(3) The name and business address of the person of

13	(b) The records required to be maintained under this section
14	must be kept for not less than one (1) year after the dog or cat is

16	(c) An owner or operator of a retail pet store shall provide the
17	board with access to the records required to be maintained under

19	Sec. 6. An owner or operator of a retail pet store shal
20	conspicuously post on the cage of a dog or cat being offered for sale
21	the name and business address of the person or organization from
22	which the dog or cat was obtained.
23	Sec. 7. An owner or operator of a retail pet store who violates
24	this chapter commits a Class C infraction.
