DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Study of lottery revenues for veterans. Urges the legislative council to assign to an appropriate interim study committee the task of studying the issues regarding allocating up to \$4,000,000 from Indiana state lottery revenues to benefit veterans.

Effective: Upon passage.

HOUSE BILL No. 1151

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning veterans.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **As used in this**
2 **SECTION, "service officer" means a specially trained individual**
3 **who provides assistance to veterans and their spouses and**
4 **dependents in applying for and obtaining veteran benefits.**
5 (b) **The legislative council is urged to assign to an appropriate**
6 **interim study committee the study of issues regarding allocation of**
7 **up to four million dollars (\$4,000,000) from Indiana state lottery**
8 **revenues to benefit veterans. An interim study committee assigned**
9 **a study under this SECTION shall consider the following:**
10 (1) **Providing grants for reimbursement for training county**
11 **and city service officers.**
12 (2) **Providing grants to purchase computer equipment and**
13 **software for county and city service officers.**
14 (c) **If an appropriate interim study committee is assigned the**
15 **topic described under subsection (b), the study committee shall**
16 **issue to the legislative council a final report containing the study**
17 **committee's findings and recommendations, including any**
18 **recommended legislation concerning the topic, in an electronic**



1 **format under IC 5-14-6, not later than November 1, 2018.**
2 **(d) This SECTION expires January 1, 2019.**
3 **SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.**
