## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 12-15-1.3-18.5.

**Synopsis:** Home and community based services waivers. Requires the office of the secretary of family and social services to apply to the United States Department of Health and Human Services for an amendment to each home and community based services Medicaid waiver to exclude the income and resources of a spouse when determining an individual's eligibility for the waiver.

Effective: July 1, 2024.
