A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning education and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015] (a) Notwithstanding
the amount appropriated in the state budget act for the bienniun
beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, there is
appropriated instead, and not in addition to, from the state genera
fund three million six hundred seventy-six thousand two hundred
forty dollars (\$3,676,240) for state fiscal year 2015-2016 and three
million six hundred seventy-six thousand two hundred forty dollars
(\$3,676,240) for state fiscal year 2016-2017 to the commission for
higher education for the National Guard tuition supplemen
program established under IC 21-13-4.

(b) The appropriations under subsection (a) for National Guard tuition supplements and any program reserves existing on June 30, 2015, is the total allowable state expenditure for the program in the 2015-2017 biennium. If the amounts for eligible awards exceed appropriations and program reserves, the commission for higher
