DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: National Guard scholarship awards. Maintains the appropriation for the National Guard tuition supplement program at the 2014-2015 state fiscal year level for the upcoming biennium.

Effective: July 1, 2015.

HOUSE BILL No. 1156



A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning education and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015] (a) **Notwithstanding**
2 **the amount appropriated in the state budget act for the biennium**
3 **beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, there is**
4 **appropriated instead, and not in addition to, from the state general**
5 **fund three million six hundred seventy-six thousand two hundred**
6 **forty dollars (\$3,676,240) for state fiscal year 2015-2016 and three**
7 **million six hundred seventy-six thousand two hundred forty dollars**
8 **(\$3,676,240) for state fiscal year 2016-2017 to the commission for**
9 **higher education for the National Guard tuition supplement**
10 **program established under IC 21-13-4.**
11 (b) **The appropriations under subsection (a) for National Guard**
12 **tuition supplements and any program reserves existing on June 30,**
13 **2015, is the total allowable state expenditure for the program in the**
14 **2015-2017 biennium. If the amounts for eligible awards exceed**
15 **appropriations and program reserves, the commission for higher**



1 **education shall develop a plan to ensure that the total dollar**
2 **amount does not exceed the appropriations under subsection (a)**
3 **and any program reserves.**
4 **(c) This SECTION expires June 30, 2017.**
