## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 12-15-5-17.

**Synopsis:** Extension of risk based managed care prohibition. Extends the prohibition against the inclusion of certain Medicaid recipients in a risk based managed care program or capitated managed care program from June 30, 2021, to June 30, 2023.

Effective: Upon passage.

4	Medicaid recipient participating in the Program of All-Inclusive Care
5	for the Elderly (PACE) program described in IC 12-15-43.
6	(b) The office may not include a Medicaid recipient who is eligible
7	to participate in the Medicare program (42 U.S.C. 1395 et seq.) and
8	receive nursing facility services in a risk based managed care program
9	or capitated managed care program.
10	(c) This section expires <del>June 30, 2021.</del> <b>June 30, 2023.</b>
11	SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
