

# HOUSE BILL No. 1159

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## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 12-15-5-17.

**Synopsis:** Extension of risk based managed care prohibition. Extends the prohibition against the inclusion of certain Medicaid recipients in a risk based managed care program or capitated managed care program from June 30, 2021, to June 30, 2023.

**Effective:** Upon passage.

## HOUSE BILL No. 1159

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A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning Medicaid.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1       SECTION 1. IC 12-15-5-17, AS AMENDED BY P.L.103-2020,  
2       SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
3       UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 17. (a) This section does not apply to a  
4       Medicaid recipient participating in the Program of All-Inclusive Care  
5       for the Elderly (PACE) program described in IC 12-15-43.  
6       (b) The office may not include a Medicaid recipient who is eligible  
7       to participate in the Medicare program (42 U.S.C. 1395 et seq.) and  
8       receive nursing facility services in a risk based managed care program  
9       or capitated managed care program.  
10      (c) This section expires ~~June 30, 2021~~. **June 30, 2023.**  
11      SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
