Synopsis: Armed officers on school property. Allows: (1) off duty; and (2) retired; law enforcement officers to carry a handgun in or on school property. Allows: (1) reserve; and (2) former reserve; law enforcement officers to carry a handgun in or on school property.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.
