

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1166

DIGEST OF HB 1166 (Updated February 19, 2020 2:37 pm - DI 135)

Citations Affected: IC 4-23.

Synopsis: State commission and board meetings. Provides that in order for the commission on Hispanic/Latino affairs to take action at a meeting, at least: (1) 11 members must be present; and (2) a majority of the members present at the meeting (instead a majority of members appointed to the commission) must vote in favor of the action.

Effective: July 1, 2020.
