## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 9-19-19-8.

**Synopsis:** Operating a vehicle with illegal window tinting. Provides that it is a Class A infraction for a person to drive a motor vehicle that has windows treated with sunscreening material or is tinted with material that has total solar reflectance of visible light above the treatment percentage prescribed by law.

**Effective:** July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-19-19-8, AS AMENDED BY P.L.164-2018,  
2 SECTION 10, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
3 JULY 1, 2023]: Sec. 8. A person who violates section **4(c) or 4(e)** of  
4 this chapter commits a Class A infraction.
