Citations Affected: IC 9-19-19-8.

Synopsis: Operating a vehicle with illegal window tinting. Provides that it is a Class A infraction for a person to drive a motor vehicle that has windows treated with sunscreening material or is tinted with material that has total solar reflectance of visible light above the treatment percentage prescribed by law.
