# HOUSE BILL No. 1175

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 12-15-5-14.5.

**Synopsis:** Supervision by behavioral health professionals. Requires that the office of Medicaid policy and planning include a licensed clinical social worker, a licensed mental health counselor, a licensed clinical addiction counselor, and a licensed marriage and family therapist who meet certain qualifications as eligible providers for the supervision of a plan of treatment for a patient's outpatient mental health or substance abuse treatment services.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning human services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

3	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 14.5. The office shall include a
4	licensed clinical social worker, a licensed mental health counselor,
5	a licensed clinical addiction counselor, and a licensed marriage and
6	family therapist as eligible providers for the supervision of a plan
7	of treatment for a patient's outpatient mental health or substance
8	abuse treatment services, if the supervision is in the scope of
9	practice, education, and training of the clinical social worker,
10	mental health counselor, clinical addiction counselor, or marriage
11	and family therapist.
