

HOUSE BILL No. 1177

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 22-5-8.

Synopsis: Drug testing of employees and applicants. Provides that, unless federal law requires otherwise, a drug test given to an individual by or on behalf of an employer, or by or on behalf of a prospective employer as a condition of an offer of employment, may not include a screening for THC.

Effective: July 1, 2018.

HOUSE BILL No. 1177

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning labor and safety.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 22-5-8 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
2 A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2018]:

4 **Chapter 8. Drug Testing of Employees and Prospective
5 Employees**

6 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "THC" has the meaning set forth
7 in IC 35-48-2-4(d)(31).**

8 **Sec. 2. A drug test given to an individual by or on behalf of:**

9 **(1) an employer; or**

10 **(2) a prospective employer as a condition of an offer of
11 employment;**

12 **may not include a screening for THC.**

13 **Sec. 3. This chapter does not apply to the extent that it conflicts
14 with or is preempted by federal law.**
