Urges the legislative council to commission Ball State University to conduct a study to be submitted to the legislative council concerning the effects of the enactment of the Indiana right to work law in 2012 on overall wages in traditionally unionized industries or sectors in Indiana.

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning labor and safety.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

I	SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) The legislative
2	council is urged to commission Ball State University to conduct a

9	unionized industries or sectors in Indiana; and
0	(2) the hourly wage growth or wage decline in traditionally
1	unionized industries or sectors in other states in the Great
2	Lakes region that have not enacted similar right to work laws.
3	(b) This SECTION expires January 1, 2022.
4	SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
