Urges the legislative council to assign to the interim study committee on energy, utilities, and telecommunications for study during the 2017 interim the topic of how adequate and affordable water utility service can be provided in areas of Indiana in which water utility service is inadequate or costly.

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning utilities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017] (a) As used in this

- (f) If the topic set forth in subsection (e) is assigned to the committee, the committee shall, as part of its study, consider specific strategies to make adequate and affordable water utility service available throughout Indiana.
- (g) If the topic set forth in subsection (e) is assigned to the committee, the committee shall issue a final report to the legislative council containing the committee's findings and recommendations, including any recommended legislation concerning the topic set forth in subsection (e), in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6 not later than November 1, 2017.
- (h) This SECTION expires December 31, 2017.
