

HOUSE BILL No. 1213

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 16-21-6-13.

Synopsis: Cost of medical procedures. Requires each hospital and ambulatory outpatient surgical center (facility) to: (1) prepare a list of the facility's average charge for the treatment of common or frequent diagnostic, inpatient, and outpatient procedures and treatment; and (2) disclose to a prospective patient before admission the facility's average charge for the procedure or treatment.

Effective: July 1, 2015.

HOUSE BILL No. 1213



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 16-21-6-13 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2015]: **Sec. 13. (a) This section does not apply to a patient
4 receiving emergency care or treatment.**
5 **(b) Each hospital and ambulatory outpatient surgical center
6 shall prepare a list of the hospital's or ambulatory outpatient
7 surgical center's average charge for the treatment of common or
8 frequent diagnostic, inpatient, and outpatient procedures and
9 treatment. The hospital's or ambulatory outpatient surgical
10 center's average charge must include any facility fees.**
11 **(c) A hospital and ambulatory outpatient surgical center shall,
12 before admission, provide to a prospective patient seeking care or
13 treatment the hospital's or ambulatory outpatient surgical center's
14 average charge for the diagnostic, inpatient, and outpatient
15 procedure or treatment.**
