

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1216

DIGEST OF HB 1216 (Updated March 21, 2019 9:33 am - DI 125)

Citations Affected: IC 12-12.7.

Synopsis: First steps program. Provides that, for purposes of determining a family's income under the first steps program, a family determining a family's income under the first steps program, a family is presumed to have an income that is not more than 250% of the federal income poverty level if the family is receiving benefits under Medicaid, the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), or the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program. Requires the division of disability and rehabilitative services to review and revise the division's policy regarding make-up therapy sessions, including defining what constitutes a "make-up" or "missed" session, based on recommendations from the interagency coordinating council.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

SECTION 2. IC 12-12.7-2-17.3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 17.3. Subject to any federal requirements under 20 U.S.C. 1431 et seq., for purposes of determining a family's income under section 17 of this chapter, a family is presumed to have an income that is not more than two hundred fifty percent (250%) of the federal income poverty level

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1	if the family is receiving benefits under any of the following:
2	(1) The Medicaid program.
3	(2) The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP).
4	(3) The Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
5	program.
6	(4) Any other program approved by the division.

Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 1. IC 12-12.7-2-6.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 6.5. Not later than November 1, 2019, the division shall review and revise the division's current policy regarding make-up therapy sessions, including defining what constitutes a "make-up" or "missed" session, based on recommendations from the council. The revised policy must allow for make-up sessions and must be based on a child's current



development progress and the goals of the individualized family service plan.".

Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively. and when so amended that said bill do pass.
