DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 36-8.

Synopsis: Public safety officer death benefits. Increases, from \$150,000 to \$250,000, the special death benefit for a member of the 1925 police pension fund, the 1937 firefighters' pension fund, the 1953 police pension fund, or the 1977 police officers' and firefighters' pension and disability fund who dies in the line of duty after June 30, 2019.

Effective: July 1, 2019.
