A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

3	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 3. (a) A person who knowingly or
4	intentionally:
5	(1) kills another human being; or
6	(2) kills a fetus that has attained viability (as defined in
7	IC 16-18-2-365);
8	while acting under sudden heat commits voluntary manslaughter, a
9	Level 2 Level 1 felony.
10	(b) The existence of sudden heat is a mitigating factor that reduces
11	what otherwise would be murder under section 1(1) of this chapter to
12	voluntary manslaughter.
