## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 21-44.

**Synopsis:** Medical residency programs. Requires that the medical education board and the graduate medical education board study the medical residency programs in northwest Indiana and prepare a report that provides recommendations to increase the number of medical residents in those residency programs.

Effective: July 1, 2019.
