

HOUSE BILL No. 1229

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 21-44.

Synopsis: Medical residency programs. Requires that the medical education board and the graduate medical education board study the medical residency programs in northwest Indiana and prepare a report that provides recommendations to increase the number of medical residents in those residency programs.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2019]: **Sec. 19. (a) The board shall study the medical residency
4 programs in northwest Indiana and prepare a report that provides
5 recommendations to increase the number of medical residents in
6 those residency programs. The report must be submitted in an
7 electronic format under IC 5-14-6 to the legislative council before
8 October 1, 2019.**

9 **(b) This section expires July 1, 2020.**
10 SECTION 2. IC 21-44-7-9 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
11 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
12 1, 2019]: **Sec. 9. (a) The board shall study the medical residency
13 programs in northwest Indiana and prepare a report that provides
14 recommendations to increase the number of medical residents in
15 those residency programs. The report must be submitted in an
16 electronic format under IC 5-14-6 to the legislative council before
17 October 1, 2019.**
